

# “Table Of Peace” Ideas for Education:

When some students finish their work they could go to the Peace Table and work on a Peace Project.

Start collecting Peace quotes - a journal of Peace Quotes.

Practice handwriting and Peace Quotes.

Make a list of peaceful places.

Write a story about Peace.

Plan a documentary film you could do to promote Peace.

Become a journalist for your local newspaper and write Peace Reports.
